A stylish alternative to the traditional pinch, pencil pleat or goblet style headings, the system allows curtains to hang in a continuous wave which is smooth, simple and elegant.

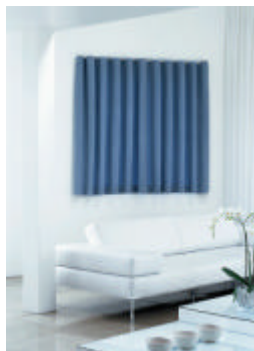
What makes Wave™ so unique?

- ~ The smooth wave effect is always maintained whether the curtains are open or closed.
- ~ The system is designed so that the curtains remain in the wave effect from the moment they are dressed.
- ~ The Wave™ heading stacks back neatly, taking up less space than traditional pleated headings.
- ~ The glider-cord is not visible when the curtain is fully closed
- ~ Different effects can be achieved through a choice of glider-cord and by adjusting the spacing between curtain hooks.
- ~ The simple, yet stylish design makes the curtains easier to make up
- ~ Depending on the fullness selected Wave can be more economical than more traditional curtains.

How does Wave™ work?

A specially designed glider-cord is contained within the curtain track. This glider-cord limits the extension of the curtain fabric, creating a smooth and continuous wave effect. When opened, the system enables the curtains to stack back neatly and straight.

Wave™ is available with the Silent Gliss Metropole Decorative Curtain Poles, as well as the 3840 Hand or Cord Operated Curtain Track and the 5100 Electrically Operated Curtain Track. Many of the fabrics included in the Signé 2 and Kelly Hoppen ranges from Silent Gliss are perfectly suited for Wave™.



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
